The treatment of Gastrointestinal Stromal Tumors (GIST) is evolving as new therapies are introduced and additional data are collected on optimal treatment strategies.

reGISTry is an observational database developed to obtain data on variations in current diagnostic and therapeutic management of patients with GIST in a variety of practice settings.

The specific objectives of *reGISTry* are:

- To describe variation in management of patients with GIST, overall and by patient and provider characteristics.
- To provide participating physicians with information regarding management of their patients with GIST compared to the aggregate experience of all physicians participating in *reGISTry*.

reGISTry is a database of “real world” care patterns. Data to be collected includes patient demographic and clinical characteristics, the previous and current medical care provided to treat this condition and clinical and economic outcomes. Patients will be followed for to one to four years.

All patients who have been diagnosed with GIST are eligible for enrollment.
